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Dear Parishioners,

Along with the verbal introduction at Mass this weekend, and the bulletin announcement, we will be introducing materials for “Together in Mission” in the coming weeks. Since the Archdiocesan Appeal was introduced to us in 1999, there have been a number of fundraising efforts I have witnessed. On a personal level I have always been grateful to witness the generosity of others. Stewardship has been present in various forms, and I am thankful for people’s ability to do their best to contribute towards the time, talent and treasure within the different communities I have served as a priest and pastor.

With the change in the Appeal name, “Together in Mission”, this year we will witness a sea change in the way we approach Stewardship both within the Diocesan Church, as well as here at St. Paul the Apostle. The approach as I understand it, will be holistic, and will take time to develop. When we hear the word Stewardship, we so often associate it with fundraising, and we lose sight that our time and our talent is a huge part of how we live the Gospel as “stewards” of God’s Kingdom.

In the coming months, with the assistance of the office of Stewardship and Mission, we will hopefully realize this change as we celebrate the opportunity to live out our faith in this parish. As we pray and discern about our participation in the Annual Appeal, I’d like to share two brief examples of stewardship that I have witnessed over the years.

The first is from an expression that was shared with the Parish community of St. Antoninus in Deloraine, Manitoba, when I first became Pastor in 1999. Deacon Murray Teetaert, a permanent deacon, who has served the local parish and community since 1997, said the following statement: “God cannot be outdone in generosity”. I wholeheartedly agree! The second example is from the late Rev. Fr. Raphael Glofcheski, who took my place at Christ the King in Stonewall and Missions in 2007. When sharing an example of the purpose of the annual appeal, he shared with the parishioners of St. John Vianney in Teulon, that the appeal amongst it’s different goals, helped to cover his salary while I was on sabbatical. He said that his presence brought no additional cost to the parish. A parishioner, a friend of mine, when Fr. Raphael had finished sharing said, “finally, after all these years, someone has made an effort to help us understand how the Appeal works. I promise you, as your pastor, to do my best to explain well the efforts we make “Together in Mission” as we move forward with this year’s Appeal.

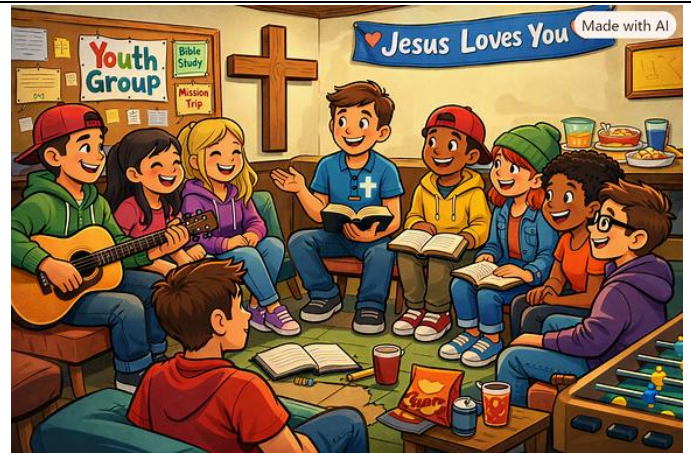
