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Dear Parishioners, This week I attended a team meeting for the Diving Deeper Adult Formation Series that is hosted at St. Joseph the Worker in Russell, Manitoba. It is the 3rd formation series offered in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg along with the Nathaniel Program and the Summons.

Last Fall there were 14 parishes represented from parishes from the Central, Westman and Parkland Deaneries West of Winnipeg. This was our first meeting which included new team members from amongst the attendees from last years sessions. There are 5 sessions on the calendar for the coming year beginning in late October. The sessions are held on Saturday from 10 am – 4 pm beginning with Mass. One of the 4 teachings for the day is held during the Holy Eucharist, followed by a second teaching before a break, with two talks in the afternoon. I was given the privilege to offer 4 talks last year, and I am presently discerning offering 3 talks in the upcoming calendar.

The primary emphasis of the talks revolved around our life and the power and presence of the Holy Eucharist. In the course of the talks that I presented, I encouraged the listeners to consider their participation in expressing their faith as an outward expression of the gift of the Holy Eucharist. As we have just celebrated the Memorial of St. Augustine. Augustine is known to have said, “behold what you are, become what you receive”. In honouring St. Augustine’s words, we are called to live the Eucharist in an outward way.

The 4 talks that I gave were Royal Priesthood, the Word of God Proclaimed, the Transformation at Mass, and Living the Eucharistic Prayers in Everyday Life. Having offered these presentations in PowerPoint form last year, I would hope to offer these talks here at St. Paul the Apostle at a later date. Having just expressed my desire to “listen” to you and discover your hopes and aspirations, I would like to have the occasion to make these presentations to you as an extension of the Diving Deeper Series. Such presentations do not need to be limited to these topics, but after 30 years of priesthood, I believe that we need to have more opportunities to learn and express our faith. As the approach the Fall and the coming months, I’m hopeful that we could create some learning opportunities for additional adult faith formation in the parish. Having sought feedback from the participants at the Diving Deeper sessions, I would hope to have a second look at my presentations and make them available for a future date. Please know that I am not trying to get ahead of myself, and my intention to keep my eyes and ears open and to observe in the coming months. I do realize that there is a different context from what an adult formation series offers, and what could be presented on the parish level. Nevertheless, I am hopeful to offer some talks in the future as the interest in learning is expressed.
