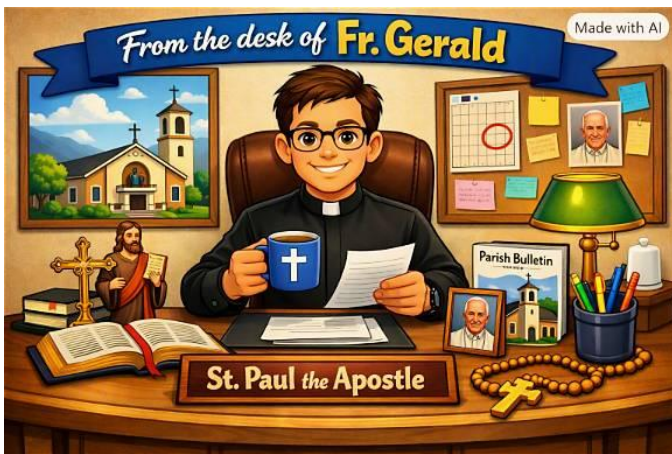

I have always considered this sound advice, inviting us to be forward-thinking in how we face the challenges that come our way. May the Lord bless us, guide us, and strengthen us each day.
